POLICY STATEMENT

A Special Case licence is designed to enable physicians to perform medical procedures in Nova Scotia over a short period of time, generally 1 – 2 days, for such things as teaching a procedure, learning a procedure, independent medical examinations, etc. Any length of time greater than two (2) days is subject to the approval of the Registrar.

Where physicians receive a fee for performing such medical procedures they will be charged a nominal fee based on the College's current fee schedule.
