Applicants for registration within Nova Scotia must have graduated from a university or school that was listed in the World Directory of Medical Schools (WDMS) at the time the candidate completed the program. It should be noted that not all schools listed on the WDMS meet the Canadian standards.

Applicants for registration within Nova Scotia must have graduated from a university or school that is located in the United States and grants a Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree accredited by the American Osteopathic Association Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation.
